RESULTS

<u>CLASS XII RESULTS</u> - 123 students from Science and Commerce stream appeared for the CBSE class XII Board examinations in March 2023. Among them, 60 students secured above 90% and 118 students secured 75% & above.

ABHISHEK. K from Science stream topped the school with a score of 492 (98.4%) RAJASREE. P of Commerce stream became the second topper with a score of 484. ANUSH KRISHNA. S, SHIVA KARTHICK. R and R. SUJITH GOPI scored 483 and shared the third position.

Seven students secured centums in Informatics Practices and 2 students scored centums in Chemistry and in Computer Science respectively.

With a score of 492 the second position has been bagged by M. Nandhini and the third topper is Nithyalakshmi. W with a score of 491.

As many as 13 students secured centums in various subjects. 6 students scored centums in Social Science and Mathematics respectively and 1 student in Tamil.

These programmes, held on the 18th, 19th, 29th, and 30th of May 2023, were designed for trained lecturers and graduate teachers. During these sessions, we provided valuable insights into the CBSE Syllabus and the National Education Policy (NEP), enabling a smooth shift from the state board curriculum to CBSE.

Mrs. Vijayalakshmi Mohan of Economics Dept. attended a two- day training programme on Recent Trends in Teaching of Economics at the Higher Secondary and Graduate level organised by the Centre for Liberal Arts and Science, Engineering and Technology (CLASET) ANNA UNIVERSITY on 1st and 2nd July 2022.

A workshop on Financial Literacy was organised for our teachers by CBSE as a part of the Teacher Enrichment programme. This happened in our school premises on 29th August 2022. The two-hour-long workshop titled BASICS OF FINANCIAL AND RETIREMENT PLANNING was headed by Sri Rajamani, an auditor by profession. Many teachers from nearby schools also attended the programme.

Mrs. Manjusha of English Department attended a capacity building programme on NGF and Physical Literacy at Bhavan's Rajaji Vidyashram on 9th September 2022.

Our Physical Education teacher Mr. Lenin took part in the seminar conducted by IPLA on the topic "Promoting Physical Literacy" on 9th September 2022.

An insightful session was conducted for the teachers by the school counsellor, Smt. Jayashree, on 22nd September 2022. The primary objective of this session was to inform teachers about the different types of learning issues children face and stress the importance of effective early intervention in such cases.

Our Vidyalaya celebrated World Heart Day with an aim to create awareness about Cardio-vascular diseases. Dr. Mahadevan, famous cardiologist addressed the teachers on 23rd September 2022 regarding heart attack, strokes and other CVDs.

A web training programme on the topic "Early years of Behavioural Development" was organised by Bharath Sahodaya on 21st October 2022 for KG and I and II handling teachers.

I had the privilege of hosting webinars under the topic 'Decoding the Class 10 English Question Paper – Part I and II' on the 7th and 28th of November 2022, These informative sessions were attended by English teachers from classes 6 to 10 and were organized by Teacher Magi in collaboration with Smartail.

WORKSHOPS BY CHINMAYA EDUCATION CELL

An induction programme was conducted by CCMT Education cell for teachers of Chinmaya Vidyalayas, Chennai on 3rd June 2022 presenting an in-depth understanding of the core values and principles of the Chinmaya Vision Programme and its integration with academics. The programme was spearheaded by principals and Vice-Principals of Chinmaya Vidyalayas, Chennai and Smt. STUDENTS' ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES:

National Reading Day and International Yoga Day were celebrated in the month of June 2022.

The Ambulance Man Badge Camp was held on 25th June 2022 at Chinmaya Vidyalaya Sr Sec School, Anna Nagar. 15 of our school Scouts and Guides attended the one-day camp.

A one-day workshop on "An Introduction to Internet of Things" was organized for the students of classes 9 and 10 by SRM Easwari Engineering College on 23rd July 2022.

To commemorate the iconic historic movement of India's 75 years of Independence, Shri Shankarlal Sundharbai Jain College organised a programme to create a World Record titled "Be a Part of the World Record" on 12th August 2022 in which class V students took part and 75 facial masks representing different freedom fighters were worn by the students and they all took national pledge.
